28th Annual GHCPA PATTY KOEHLER Memorial Scholarship Tournament Rules

(THIS IS NOT THE GENERATION GAP TOURNAMENT ENTRY FORM)

1. This tournament will run in conjunction with the Generation Gap Tournament. The participant may enter every squad. The entry fee **MUST** accompany the entry form.
Entries will close 30 minutes prior to squad times.

2. AVERAGES, HANDICAP

All participants must be a 2017-2018 USBC-Youth Division member **and must currently be participating in a GHUSBC-certified youth league, including the Greater Houston Youth Travel Leagues OR if at least one bowler on a team entered in the Generation gap Tournament is a youth member that meets the above criteria, then the other youth team members are eligible.** Validate average and current participation with signature from the league coach or representative.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE TIME OF CHECK-IN.

- A) Use the highest 2016-2017 book average of 21 games or more*. **Must provide copy of book average if from association other than GHUSBC.**
- B) Highest current Avg. of 15 games or more as of January 1, 2018*. **Must be accompanied by a standing sheet.**
- C) If neither Rule A nor B apply, use the highest verifiable 2017 summer average with 15 games or more*. **Must be accompanied by a standing sheet.**
- D) If not A, B, or C ***you are not eligible to bowl in the scholarship tournament.***

***If Sport/Challenge average is only average available, it will be adjusted per USBC Sport Bowling Average Adjustment Chart.** Bowlers will be responsible for certification of averages and **MUST** sign the entry form. Penalty for incorrect averages may result in disqualification, at the discretion of the tournament director.

HANDICAP WILL BE BASED ON 100% FROM 200.

3. Qualification round will be scores from the bowler's entry in the Generation Gap Tournament (3-game scores + handicap). Multiple participation will be allowed in the Scholarship Tournament with each Generation Gap Tournament entry.
4. There will be four boys and three girls divisions: **Bowler's Average will determine his/her division.**
"1" Boys - 165 & Up "2" Boys - 119 - 164 "3" Boys - 118 & Under
"4" Girls - 140 & Up "5" Girls - 139 & Under
5. The top five in each division will advance to the finals, bowling a stair step format. In the case of a tie for the top 5 during the tournament, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll-off. In case of another tie there will be a 10th frame roll-off until a winner is declared. The finals will be held on Sunday Feb.4, 2018 at 9:30a.m. Roll call will be at 9:30a.m. (If you are in the top 5 and fail to appear for the finals, you are not eligible for scholarships awarded for places 1-5).
6. Scholarships will be awarded based on the number of entries in each division using a ratio of 1 in 10. Scholarship fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers in the form of scholarships. Scholarship funds for this tournament are deposited with the USBC SMART PROGRAM, GHCPA Account.
7. Appropriate dress will be required for all bowlers. Tailored walking shorts and skirts will be allowed as long as the bowler, when standing up straight with arms down is not able to touch skin. **NO BIKE OR SPANDEX SHORTS, CUTOFF PANTS, TANK TOPS, MIDRIFFS (skin showing), HALTER-TOPS, MINI-SKIRTS. NO ATIRE WITH INAPPROPRIATE SEXUAL OR RACIAL REFERENCES, OR REFERENCING OBSCENITIES, TOBACCO, OR ALCOHOL WILL BE ALLOWED. THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED.** Bowlers will be responsible for complying with the dress code. The penalty will be that the bowler will not be allowed to participate.
8. USBC rules, regulations and codes will govern this tournament. Coaches or their representatives will be responsible for the verification of series and certification of averages.
9. All bowlers should check in at the tournament desk at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time.
10. Bowlers will be required to stay in the bowlers' settee area. A bowler may be disqualified for conduct detrimental to the best interest of the tournament, either on or off the lanes.
11. The entry fee must accompany the entry form in the form of a check, cashiers check, money order, or cash. Checks need to be made payable to the GHUSBC (Greater Houston United States Bowling Congress). Entry Fee: 100% to Scholarship Awards Fund.
12. Any appeal or protest regarding scoring or eligibility must be made, in writing, to the tournament director within 72 hours after the error or infraction has occurred.
13. Mail entries to Tom Little, 14707 Jade Glen Ct, Sugar Land, TX 77498. **ENTRY DEADLINE: January 15, 2018 for reserved lanes. Entries received after that date will be accepted only if lanes are available.**
14. Tournament Director is Tom Little for qualifying squads and for Finals.
