TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games per event. Teams are 4 members- consisting of any average combination. This tournament is open to all youth members in the geographic boundaries of the GHUSBC. To qualify, bowler must have not reached their 18th birthday as of August 1, 2024. The tournament consists of Handicap divisions with Team, Doubles, Singles (male & female) and optional All Events. DIVISIONS ARE ALL BASED ON AVERAGES.
2. AVERAGES: (A) Highest Book Average (Winter or Summer 2023-2024) of 21 games or more*; (B) Highest Current Average of 9 games or more as of **December 31, 2024***. (Standing sheets for current averages, which must include all games bowled as of **12/31/24**, Summer standing sheets, and average book from other associations, must be submitted to the GHUSBC office). (C) If no A or B, use average as of date of participation with a minimum of 9 games* (D) If no A, B, or C use entering average as follows: Ages 12-18 – Male – 160, Female – 140; Ages 9-11 – Male & Female – 110; Ages 8 & under – Male & Female – 75. ***If Sport/ Challenge average is only average available, it will be adjusted per USBC Sport Bowling Average Adjustment Chart**
3. HANDICAP: 100% based on a base score of 220.
4. Multiple entries will be allowed in the Team and Doubles events. Singles can be bowled only once. In order to place more than once for an award, at least two players on the team must be different and the doubles partners must change. Singles & All Events may place only once. When a bowler competes more than once in an event, their highest score in each event shall count towards ALL-EVENTS. IF bowling multiple doubles, singles must be scheduled on the same squad as one of the doubles. All bowlers entering the singles event must enter the doubles event and vice-versa. All bowlers must enter team, doubles, and singles to be eligible for optional All Events. The singles event will be bowled first on your assigned pair of lanes, and the doubles event will be bowled immediately after completing singles ON THE SAME PAIR OF LANES. There will be ten minutes warm-up before the team and singles events. No practice balls will be allowed between singles and doubles events. USBC RULES & REGULATIONS WILL GOVERN THIS TOURNAMENT & ARE AVAILABLE IN THE TOURNAMENT OFFICE.
5. Coaches will be responsible for certification of averages and youth membership and must sign the entry form. Bowlers entered in the wrong classification or with incorrect averages may be disqualified if correction is not made prior to completing the first series bowled in the tournament.
6. APPROPRIATE ATTIRE WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ALL BOWLERS – female participants may wear skirts no shorter than 2” above the top of the knee cap. Tailored walking shorts, no shorter than 2” above the top of the knee cap. NO – hats, caps, tank tops, biker shorts, spandex shorts. NO attire advertising “obscenities, tobacco or alcohol” will be allowed. THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED. Coaches are responsible for dress code. The tournament director or representative will determine proper attire, and a bowler will be required to change or possibly be disqualified.
7. Use of cell phones during competition will not be allowed.
8. Check-in is 30 minutes prior to scheduled squad time.
9. Line-up on entry form is the official line-up and will not be changed except for substitutions. A substitute may be used in the event of injury, illness or absenteeism of regular bowlers.
10. Bowlers will be required to stay in the bowler’s settee area. A bowler may be disqualified for conduct detrimental to the best interest of the tournament or the sport of bowling.
11. **ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORMS. BOWLING CENTER CHECK, MONEY ORDER, CASHIERS CHECK ONLY. NO PERSONAL CHECKS. PLEASE NO CASH IF MAILED. PARTIAL ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. ALL AWARD FEES WILL BE RETURNED 100%. Plaques awarded in each event by division based on 1:10 ratio. Scholarships guaranteed for 1st place in each division in each event.**
12. Any appeal /protest regarding scores / eligibility must be made in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours after the error / infraction has occurred. (See USBC rule book for correct procedure).
